TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. All the placements stated above under the Child Protection Scheme are purely on contractual basis for a period of 03 years.
2. The appointment shall not confer any right for regularization in future.
3. The Members shall be selected through walk-in-interview of the eligible applicants.
4. Candidates fulfilling the above eligibility criteria as prescribed against each post shall apply.
5. Candidates must be in good health and physically fit to discharge his/her duties.
6. Applicants for the post of Chairperson and member of CWC should be above the age of 30 (thirty) years at the time of submission of application or on the last date of submission of application.
7. Applicants for the post of member of JJB should not be less than 30 (thirty) years of age at the time of submission of application or on the last date of submission of application.
8. The Chairperson of the District CWC will be nominated by the State Government amongst the selected candidates of CWC.
9. Selected candidates are liable to be posted in any districts.
10. Application for Chairperson and Member, CWC can be submitted in one application. However, separate application must be submitted for the post of Member of JJB.

Interested candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria must submit the application along with resume addressed to the Additional Secretary-cum-Director, CPS, SJ&WD, with the following valid documents, email id and contact numbers, to the office of the Under Secretary, CPS, Social Justice & Welfare Department, 5th Mile, Lumsey East Sikkim on or before **9th October 2020** latest by 4 p.m. Only those applications with prescribed and properly attested documents received within the stipulated date and time shall be entertained.

2. Attested copy of Sikkim Subject Certificate/Certificate of Identification from the Concerned Authority.
3. Attested copy of valid Local Employment Card.
4. No Objection Certificate from the Secretary, Head of Department in the case of any temporary employee serving in Government Departments.
5. Experience Certificate duly certified by the relevant Issuing Authority.
