NOTICE

During the Disability assessment Camp, the following Medical Authorities/Specialists from S.T.N.M Hospital and District Hospital, Namchi will be examining and assessing the percentage of disability.

1. Orthopaedic Surgeon
2. E.N.T Specialist
3. Ophthalmologist
4. Psychiatrist

The above Medical Authorities will examine the disability relating to the Blindness, Low Vision, Leprosy Cured, Hearing Impairment, Locomotor Disability, Multiple disabilities and Mental Illness. The Dwarfs above the age of 18 years may also attend the camp.

The Disability Camps will be organized at the following Primary Health Centers on the dates mentioned against each camp.

The beneficiaries are requested to bring the photocopy of Electoral Identity Card or Ration Card or Aadhar Card and Income Certificate duly issued by the Gram Vikash Adhikari or Revenue Officer of the locality. The beneficiaries will be issued Disability Certificate, Disability Identity Cards and Aids/Appliances on the spot on the recommendation of the above Medical Authorities.

The Panchayat members, Anganwadi workers, Self Help Groups, Voluntary Organizations and Well wishers are requested to kindly bring this information to the notice of all differently abled persons to avail the benefits.
